RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 202

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLAYTON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, IN CONJUNCTION WITH COMMISSIONER GAIL HAMBRICK'S RECOGNITION OF VOLUNTEERS IN DISTRICT 2, TO HOST ITS ANNUAL FALL FESTIVAL AT FLAT SHOALS PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Department of Parks and Recreation ("CCPR") wishes to utilize Flat Shoals Park located at 1915 Flat Shoals Road in Riverdale, Georgia (the "Location") to host its Annual Fall Festival which will include music, food, balloon art, moonwalk, zip line, rock wall, clowns, face painting, train and pony rides, costume contest, magician, arts and craft, DJ, live entertainment and vendors; and

WHEREAS, CCPR wishes to host the Fall Festival in conjunction with Commissioner Gail Hambrick's recognition of volunteers in District 2; and

WHEREAS, the Fall Festival will be held on October 20, 2012 from approximately 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., and will provide citizens an opportunity to celebrate Fall Season with games and activities in a fun and safe environment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing CCPR to host this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County Parks and Recreation to host its Annual Fall Festival, in conjunction with Commissioner Gail Hambrick's recognition of volunteers in District 2, to be held on October 20, 2012, at Flat Shoals Park. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.


