RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 206

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A FORFEITED VEHICLE FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN INVESTIGATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF SUCH PROPERTY IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT THE REQUIRED APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County District Attorney's Office Task Force Division participated in an investigation that led to the seizure of a 2007 Cadillac Escalade, VIN number 1GYEC63827R254925, during a drug trafficking investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County District Attorney's Office was awarded the vehicle by the Department of the Treasury for participation in the investigation; and

WHEREAS, the plea entered by the defendant, Kory Drayton, forfeited ownership and title of said vehicle to the Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Customs and Border Protection under court order in case numbers 2011170400035801 and 2011SZ010039601; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought can be effectively used to the benefit of the County for confidential investigative purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting said vehicle in accordance with applicable County Ordinances and used for limited purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept a 2007 Cadillac Escalade, VIN number 1GYEC63827R254925 to be used for the above stated purposes. The Directors of Central Services and Finance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


