RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 220

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT FROM CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE DISPOSAL OF SAID EQUIPMENT AS COUNTY OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE DISPOSAL OF SUCH PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services (hereinafter “CCFES”) desires to dispose of two 1996 E-One, 75’ Ladder Cyclone Stratosphere Fire Engines and one 1995 E-One, 75’ Ladder Cyclone Stratosphere Fire Engine; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicles sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used to benefit the County and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of one unserviceable vehicle and two high mileage vehicles in accordance with all applicable County Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOVLED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to sell or otherwise dispose of the 1995 and two 1996 E-One, 75’ Ladder Cyclone Stratosphere Fire Engines. The sale or disposal shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with all applicable County Ordinances. The


Director of Central Services is further authorized to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


