RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 261

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A FORFEITED VEHICLE TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FLEET IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Uniform Patrol Division impounded a 1996 Tan Chevrolet Caprice VIN 1G1BL52W2TR175700 during a criminal investigation conducted by the Clayton County Police Department Uniform Division; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County forfeited ownership and title of said vehicle to the Clayton County Police Department under civil action number 2012-CV-01523-9; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Fleet Maintenance has determined said vehicle to be suitable for service as a county vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting said vehicle and assigning it to the Clayton County Police Department to enhance law enforcement in accordance with applicable State statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept title to a 1996 Tan Chevrolet Caprice VIN 1G1BL52W2TR175700; and to assign said vehicle to the Clayton County Police Department vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement in

accordance with Clayton County Superior Court order number 2012-CV-01523-9. The Directors of Central Services and Fleet Maintenance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
