RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 76

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF JONESBORO REGARDING THE APPROVAL OF CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR THE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND JUSTICE CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF JONESBORO; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro issues permits for the construction of facilities within the municipal boundaries of the city; and

WHEREAS, the County is in the process of constructing a new Youth Development and Justice Center Project to be located within the municipal boundaries of the city in the vicinity of the existing Harold Banke Justice Complex; and

WHEREAS, although adequate parking for the new structure can be accommodated utilizing existing parking on site, plans for the new facility include additional parking in the form of an asphalt lot; and

WHEREAS, the County has submitted plans to the City for review which include the design, site dimensions, storm profile, grading and drainage specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to review the plans in their entirety and provide approval for the County to construct the additional parking if such parking is required in the future without the need for further approvals by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into an agreement with the City of Jonesboro as contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED






Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its final passage.




