RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 109

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FEES CHARGED TO RECIPIENT OF SUCH SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, AND TO TRANSFER ANY REQUIRED MATCH OF LOCAL FUNDS, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County, through its Fire Department finds a need to adjust Emergency Medical Service ("EMS") fees charged for services provided to recipients of EMS services; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens, and the County will best be served by increasing the fees for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes an increase in Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") fees charged to recipients of EMS services in the following particulars:

Basic Life Support Transportation (Type 1 Transport)	\$560.00
Basic Life Support Transportation (Type 2 Transport)	\$608.00
Advanced Life Support Transportation (Type 1 Transport)	\$670.00
Advanced Life Support Transportation (Type 2 Transport)	\$776.00

Delivery of Oxygen	\$50.00
Mileage (per mile)	\$10.00
Assessment—treat/release	\$120.00
Extrication	\$350.00
Spinal immobilization	\$50.00
Preparation for air transport	\$542.50
Administration of EKG	\$40.00

The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute any necessary documents and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of the resolution.

Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect and appropriate revenue source and expense, and to transfer any required match of local funds, all as may be required under the terms of this Resolution.

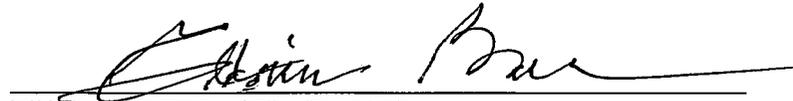
Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

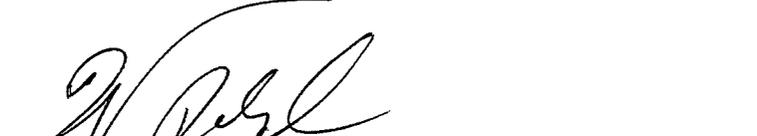

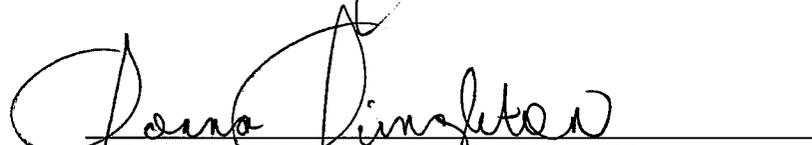

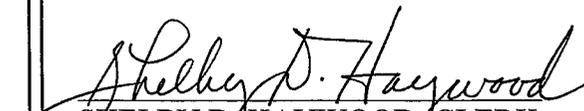
