RESOLUTION 2011 – 98

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF THE AVIATION UNIT OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES ARMY APPROVED AND COORDINATED THROUGH THE GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, FOR A SURPLUS HELICOPTER (NOT IN FLYING CONDITION) TO BE USED FOR PARTS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Aviation Unit of the Clayton County Police Department desires to obtain a surplus military helicopter now in the possession of the Fayette County Sheriff's Office with registration number N338FC; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Emergency Management Agency has approved and will coordinate this transfer; and

WHEREAS, this surplus helicopter will be used for parts and will not be put into flying condition without further permission from the Board of Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Clayton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to enter into an agreement, on behalf of the Aviation Unit of the Clayton County Police Department, with the United States Army for the

transfer of an OH-58A helicopter with registration number N338FC which is not in flying condition. Said helicopter will be used for parts.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or the Chief of Police acting as his designee, to execute the agreement on behalf of the County and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




