RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 161

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT, ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, WITH TENET HEALTHSYSTEM GB, INC., D/B/A/ ATLANTA MEDICAL CENTER PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH TRAUMA SPECIALIST EDUCATION OBSERVATION WILL BE ADMINISTERED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Tenet HealthSystem GB, Inc., d/b/a Atlanta Medical Center (“AMC”) and Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services Department wish to enter into an Agreement to provide educational experiences for students at Atlanta Medical Center who are participating in the Trauma Nurse Specialist Training Educational Experience; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement will allow such participating Atlanta Medical Center students to ride along to experience, via observation only, the very best in pre-hospital trauma care; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into the entering into the Agreement for the above stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

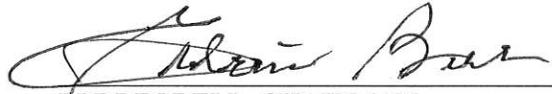
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Agreement, on behalf of the Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services Department, with Tenet HealthSystem GB, Inc., d/b/a Atlanta Medical Center providing for the terms and conditions under which Trauma Nurse Specialist Training will be administered. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the agreement attached hereto and Exhibit “A” and otherwise perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of

Commissioners authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the County's budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.

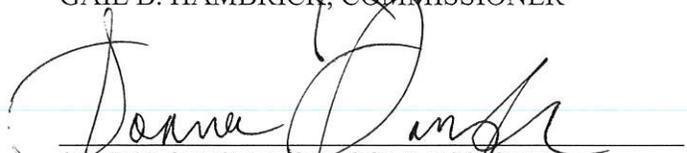
