RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 167

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT FORFEITED VEHICLES FROM CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATIONS; TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISBURSAL OF SALE PROCEEDS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police-Drug Task Force Division seized a 1998 Infiniti Q45, VIN JNKBY31A2WM400863 and a 1972 Chevrolet Monte Carlo, VIN 1H57H2B679891 during a drug investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police-Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicles to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton has forfeited ownership and titles of said vehicles to the County under court order in civil action case number 2011-CV-00739-8; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicles sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the said vehicles in accordance with applicable County Ordinances with the proceeds from said auction to be distributed per the Court's orders.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to auction a 1998 Infiniti Q45, VIN JNKBY31A2WM400863 and a 1972 Chevrolet Monte Carlo, VIN

1H57H2B679891; described in the Court's orders. The auction shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-147 of the Clayton County Code Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of these disposable vehicles shall be distributed as directed in the Court's orders. The Directors of Central Services and Finance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






