RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 177

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM KAISER PERMANENTE ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY'S DEPARTMENT OF SENIOR SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO ACCEPT THE DONATION ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY, AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Kaiser Permanente donated \$500.00 to Clayton County Department of Senior Services for the purchase of fruits and vegetables for the upcoming Sickness Prevention Achieved Through Regional Collaboration ("SPARC") event to be held at the Frank Bailey Senior Center on October 14, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by accepting the donation for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

SO RESOLVED, this the 11th of October 2011.




