RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 196

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO EXECUTE AN EASEMENT FOR STORM WATER AND SURFACE DRAINAGE IN CONNECTION WITH THE COUNTY LANDFILL; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE EASEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Authority approved a request on August 25, 2011 for a drainage easement on Clayton County Landfill property for the benefit of an adjacent private property owner, Hastings Bridge Pavilion, located at 11754 Hastings Bridge Road, Lovejoy, Georgia (the "Property"), for the purpose of allowing storm water and surface drainage from the Landfill property to discharge in the easement area; and

WHEREAS, the Property has a storm water outfall pipe associated with its detention pond installed legally within the buffer area of the Landfill; and

WHEREAS, granting a draining easement at this location will not impact any operational components or permit conditions related to the Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by executing a drainage easement on Landfill property for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to execute an easement for storm water and surface drainage in connection with the Clayton County Landfill for the benefit of an adjacent private property owner, Hastings Bridge Pavilion, located at 11754 Hastings Bridge Road,


Lovejoy, Georgia, for the purpose of allowing storm water and surface drainage from the Landfill property to discharge in the easement area. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Easement for Storm Water and Surface Drainage and otherwise perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Easement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Board of Commissioners may approve.

Section 2. The effective date of this Resolution shall be when approved by the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County.
