RESOLUTION 2011 – 211

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO BE ADDED AS A PARTICIPANT TO A STATEWIDE CONTRACT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES FOR THE PROVISION OF FACILITY MAINTENANCE SERVICES AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY HAROLD R. BANKE JUSTICE CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PROVIDE FOR IN THE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in July 2007 Clayton County entered into an agreement with Carter Goble Lee Engineering, Inc., (“CGL”) for the provision of facility maintenance services at the Harold R. Banke Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, the County’s current agreement with CGL will expire as of December 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, CGL has an existing Statewide Contract with the Georgia Department of Administrative Services for facility maintenance services similar to those currently being provided to the County’s Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County recognizes the benefits of participating in a Statewide Contract with CGL to obtain facility maintenance services at competitive prices; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interests of the County, and the County will best be served by participating in a Statewide Contract with CGL for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to be added as a participant to a Statewide Contract with the Georgia Department of Administrative Services and CGL for the provision of facility maintenance services at the Harold R. Banke Justice Center. CGL's Proposal to Provide Facility Maintenance Services is attached hereto. The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute any necessary documents and to perform all other act necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Finance to provide an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Contract.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

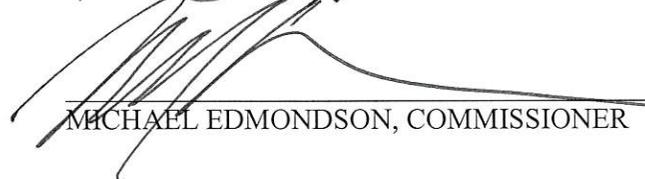
