RESOLUTION 2010 – 45

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO APPROVE THE AGREEMENT FOR PRIVATE MISDEMEANOR PROBATION SERVICES FOR THE SUPERIOR, STATE AND MAGISTRATE COURTS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE APPROVAL TOGETHER WITH ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County in 2005 executed private probation services agreements on behalf of the Superior, State, and Magistrate Courts, respectively, with Sentinel Offenders Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judges of the respective courts, notified the County that the courts did not desire to utilize the services of Sentinel under the previous agreement beyond December 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Courts, with the assistance of the County's Purchasing Agent begin a process to select a service provider and enter into new agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Courts have submitted pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 42-8-100, a proposed contract with Judicial Correction Services, Inc for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by giving its approval for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS;


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to approve the proposed contract for Misdemeanor Probation and Management Services with Judicial Correction Services, Inc. in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A", submitted by the Chief Judges of the Superior, State and Magistrate Courts, respectively, pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated section 42-8-100. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to approve the request on behalf of the county for an Initial Term of One (1) year, any extensions beyond one year shall likewise require the approval of the Board. Further the Chairman is authorized to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




