RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 51

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF AN AWARD OF \$8,000.00 FROM THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE ORGANIZED FRAUD TASK FORCE (OFTF) TO SUPPLEMENT AND ENHANCE THE JOINT INVESTIGATIONS OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE OFTF IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Criminal Investigative Division regularly participates in joint fraud investigations with the United States Secret Service Organized Fraud Task Force (OFTF); and

WHEREAS, the United States Secret Service Organized Fraud Task Force (OFTF) has budgeted an \$8,000.00 award to the Clayton County Police Department to provide for additional training, certifications, or purchases of equipment to further enhance joint investigations; and

WHEREAS, these supplemental funds are being awarded to the Clayton County Police Department at no cost to the citizens of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting said award and supplementing the budget of the Clayton County Police Department to enhance law enforcement in accordance with applicable Federal Statutes and guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept an \$8,000.00 award from the United States Secret Service Organized Fraud Task Force; to amend the budget of the Clayton County Police Department for the purpose of providing additional training, certifications, or purchases of equipment to enhance joint investigations with the Secret Service; to establish a special line item budget account to provide for the accounting of this award and related expenditures. The Director of Finance is authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




