RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 56

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO ADOPT LEGISLATION DESIGNATED IN THE COUNTY'S 2010 LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, Georgia and Clayton County, Georgia will best be served by supporting the passage of legislation set forth in the County's 2010 Legislative Package. The items listed in the package are necessary to support economic growth, and help resolve transportation issues in the region and also increase the efficient operations of County government; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County, Georgia (the "Board of Commissioners") supports the passage of such legislation as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate these purposes, it is necessary that the Clayton County, Georgia State Legislative Delegation have the Georgia General Assembly Office of Legislative Counsel prepare legislation as described herein below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby officially requests that the Clayton County, Georgia State Legislative Delegation approach the Office of Legislative Counsel to draft and sponsor legislation and or support the following measures:

1. Request that the General Assembly pass legislation further supporting the development of enhanced 911 systems in order to provide a unified 911 system in the county to support interoperable public safety communications across all public safety disciplines of the county and the municipalities.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby officially requests that the Clayton County Local Legislative Delegation take appropriate legislative steps to accomplish the goals set forth herein, and to enact the legislation during the current 2010 Legislative Session of the Georgia General Assembly.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute any document necessary and otherwise to perform all necessary acts to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


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
