RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 139

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS UNDER THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,000 TO BE USED FOR THE PRETRIAL INTERVENTION PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has been allocated over 13 million dollars for various programs under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County") is one of several metropolitan counties that are eligible to participate and apply for funds under the grant program; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's office is applying for grant funds in the amount of \$85,000, which will not require a matching of funds by the County, to be used to strengthen its Pretrial Intervention and Diversion Program by adding personnel, planning and evaluation processes and training and technology improvements;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by approving the application for grant funds for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby approves the application of the Clayton County District Attorney's Office for grant funds in the amount of \$85,000.00 under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, to be used for the Pretrial Intervention and

Diversion Program, with a no local match required by the County. This approval is subject to the District Attorney's Office complying with all conditions and requirements of the grant application process. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all documents necessary, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


