RESOLUTION NO. 2010-143

A RESOLUTION TO IDENTIFY AND PROVIDE FOR THE RETURN TO THE COUNTY OF CERTAIN COUNTY OWNED AUTOMOBILES; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County") adopted Resolution No. 2010-138 on June 29, 2010; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution directed the Chief of Staff and others to review various policies of the County related to travel and vehicle use to determine whether further cost savings can be obtained by modifications to those policies; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Staff and others have begun said review and have made certain determinations, and

WHEREAS, one of the determinations is that it is not necessary for the operation of the office of the Tax Commissioner to provide two vehicles which are driven home by an employee of said office and by the Tax Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, it has been further determined that the remaining vehicles assigned to the Tax Commissioners office are sufficient to allow said office to perform all of the functions required of it by law; and

WHEREAS, said review has further disclosed no other Tax Commissioner's office in the metro Atlanta area where vehicles are taken home by the commissioner or employees of the office; and

WHEREAS, the County believes that it is important for the financial welfare of the County to take the following measures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners, consistent with the provisions of Resolution 2010-138, hereby directs that the below listed county owned vehicles are not necessary for the performance of the duties of the office of the Tax Commissioner and therefore that the assignment of said vehicles to the office of the Tax Commissioner is hereby revoked.

Section 2. The Tax Commissioner is hereby directed to cause said vehicles to be returned to the Clayton County Fleet Maintenance Department not later than 4:30 p.m. Wednesday July 7, 2010.


