RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 181

A RESOLUTION BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE A REFUND OF TAX SALE PROCEEDS TO GREYFIELD RESOURCES, INC.; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO AUTHORIZE THE TAX COMMISSIONER TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County conducted a tax sale in order to recover outstanding property taxes and other fees related to Tax Parcel ID #12204B B001; and

WHEREAS, Greyfield Resources, Inc. was the successful bidder at the tax sale and paid \$15,000.00 to the Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the County has invalidated the sale due to two superior IRS liens which were not discovered when the title was examined; and

WHEREAS, due to the invalid tax sale Greyfield Resources, Inc. has requested a refund of the funds paid to the County and is entitled to a refund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by refunding the proceeds of the tax sale as provided herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to refund tax sale proceeds paid by Greyfield Resources, Inc. in the amount of \$15,000.00. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Tax Commissioner to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


