RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 28

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR CONSULTING SERVICES TO CONDUCT A DISPARITY STUDY FOR CLAYTON COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County seeks to maximize opportunities for all businesses desiring to participate in the County's procurement and contracting process; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to determine whether there have been any barriers that have adversely affected certain businesses ability to participate in the procurement and contracting processes of the County; and

WHEREAS, to make such a determination it is necessary to conduct a Disparity Study; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by authorizing the Director of Central Services to issue a Request for Proposals for a Consultant to conduct the Disparity Study.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through the Director of Central Services, to issue a Request for Proposals for Consultant Services for the purpose of conducting a Disparity Study to determine whether certain business have been adversely affected in their ability to participate in the County's procurement and contracting process. The Request for proposals shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit

"A", subject to such minor modifications as may be deemed necessary by the Director of Central Services.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






