ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 73

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF THE PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT TO THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE ORDINANCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by renaming the Personnel Department to the Human Resources Department to better reflect the duties and functions of the Department due to the reorganization that combined the functions of the Risk Management Department with the Personnel Department.

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the intent of the ordinance it is necessary to amend the budget to reflect the appropriate revenue sources and expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to rename the Personnel Department to the Human Resources Department and to change the title of the Personnel Director to the Director of Human Resources. Any references in the Clayton County Code of Ordinances, the Civil Service Rules and Regulations or any previously adopted ordinances or resolutions which refer to the Personnel Director shall mean the Human Resources Director.

Section 2. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and the Human Resources Director are hereby authorized to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the tasks necessary to accomplish the intent of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to amend the budget where necessary to reflect the appropriate revenue sources and expenses.


Section 4. Should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional. All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of its adoption by the Board of Commissioners.




