RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 106

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH FAYETTE COUNTY FOR CERTAIN RESURFACING WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY FAYETTE COUNTY ON CORINTH ROAD; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT THE APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENSES RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County and Fayette County desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (the "IGA") for the completion of certain resurfacing work (the "Project") to be performed by Fayette County on Corinth Road to promote an adequate and safe means of transportation; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County and Fayette County desire to coordinate their efforts and work together on the Project pursuant to their respective Resolutions; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County agrees that this IGA will be reimbursable to Fayette County; and

WHEREAS, reimbursable funds are being based on an engineering estimate at the present time in the amount of \$90,000.00, with a contingency of plus fifteen percent (+15%) should pricing increase prior to the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and that the County will best be served by entering into an IGA for the stated purpose.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to

enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Fayette County for certain resurfacing work to be performed by Fayette County on Corinth Road, with an engineering estimate at the present time in the amount of \$90,000.00, with a contingency of plus fifteen percent (+15%) should pricing increase prior to the completion of the project. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect the appropriations and expenses relating thereto.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


