RESOLUTION 2009 – 116

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRIP WIRE REAL TIME SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM, NIGHT VISION EQUIPMENT, LEVEL III PROTECTIVE VESTS AND LAPTOPS TO MANAGE THE TRIP WIRE SYSTEM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice through Project Safe Neighborhoods has provided grant money to target gang activity; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department has been approved to receive a \$50,000.00 grant to purchase equipment to be used to combat gang activity; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems that it is in the best interest of Clayton County to participate in this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED



The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the grant agreement, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where


necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






