RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 122

A RESOLUTION TO RENAME EAST CLAYTON DRIVE TO QUIKTRIP WAY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT TO ERECT SIGNS ON THE SUBJECT STREET THAT REFLECT THE RENAMING; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, East Clayton Drive was constructed by private developers and accepted by Clayton County in March 2009; and

WHEREAS, QuikTrip Corporation suggested the renaming of East Clayton Drive to QuikTrip Way with the opening of its QuikTrip Kitchens facility on East Clayton Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development mailed notices to the adjacent six property owners on East Clayton Drive, informing them of the proposed renaming and requesting their opinion on the matter; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County to rename East Clayton Drive to QuikTrip Way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the renaming of East Clayton Drive in Clayton County, Georgia to QuikTrip Way; and authorizes the Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development to erect signs along the subject street that reflect the renaming.


The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chairman to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution; and authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.

The implementation date of the renaming of East Clayton Drive to QuikTrip Way shall occur sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this the 4th day of August, 2009.




