RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 144

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CONDEMNED VEHICLE TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FLEET IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Uniform Division seized a 2002 Ford F150 pickup truck, VIN # 1FTRX17W82NB15924 during a drug investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicle to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton has forfeited said vehicle to the County under court order in case number 2009-CV-00437-8; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Fleet Maintenance has determined said vehicle is suitable for service as a county vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting said vehicle and assigning it to the Clayton County Police Department to enhance law enforcement in accordance with applicable State Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED



The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept a 2002 Ford F150 pickup truck, VIN # 1FTRX17W82NB15924; to assign said vehicle to the Clayton County Police Department uniform vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement in accordance with Clayton County Superior Court order number 2009-CV-00437-8.

The Directors of Central Services and Fleet Maintenance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
