RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 147

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, BY AND THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT TO REMOVE THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF MT. ZION BLVD AT LANDMARK DODGE DRIVEWAY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the traffic signal located at the intersection of Mt. Zion Blvd at Landmark Dodge Driveway does not meet the traffic signal warrants and justification as identified in the Federal Highway Administration's Manual on Uniform Traffic control Devices; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Transportation Department recommends the removal of said traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by removing the traffic signal for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Clayton County Transportation and Development Department to remove the traffic signal at the intersection of Mt. Zion Blvd at Landmark Dodge Driveway.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary on behalf of the County and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




