RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 158

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNCIL OF JUVENILE COURT JUDGES OF GEORGIA AND IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT ASSOCIATED WITH THE PURCHASE OF SERVICES PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Juvenile Court (the "Juvenile Court") applied for and was awarded a Purchase of Services grant in the amount of \$7,500.00; with no local match from the County required; from the Council of Juvenile Court Judges of Georgia for Purchase of Services funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Clayton County to enter into an Agreement with the Council of Juvenile Court Judges of Georgia for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONER OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

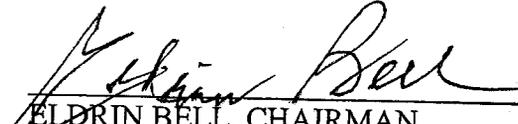
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Agreement on behalf of the Clayton County Juvenile Court with the Council of Juvenile Court Judges of Georgia, and in accordance therewith accept grant funds to be used in connection with the Purchase of Services Program. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

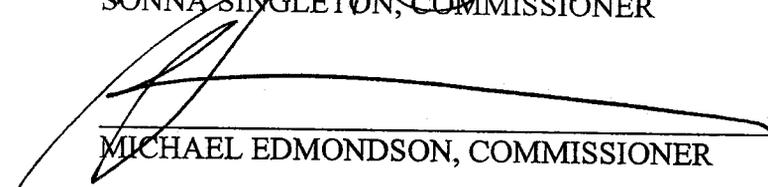

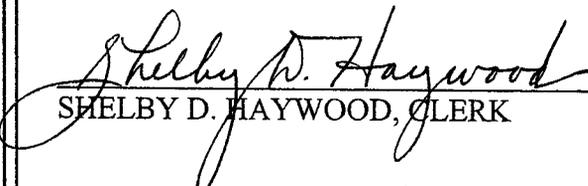
