RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 169

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF C-TRAN FIXED ROUTE SERVICES AND CORRESPONDING COMPLEMENTARY PARATRANSIT SERVICES; TO PROVIDE EFFECTIVE DATES FOR THE TERMINATION ADOPTED IN THIS RESOLUTION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County provides public transit service through the operation of C-TRAN, said service being funded through an appropriation in the County's Fiscal Year 2010 operating budget; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2009-152 adopted September 15, 2009, the Board of Commissioners identified proposed service reductions, including termination of C-Tran Fixed Route and complementary Paratransit service and fare increases for C-TRAN services, scheduled a public hearing, and authorized the solicitation of public comment regarding such service reductions and fare increases, in accordance with the public comment policy adopted by Resolution Number 2009-71; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 7, 2009 after notice was provided as required by said public comment policy, and public comment was solicited through October 12, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing Officer has submitted a summary of public comments to the Board of Commissioners as required by said policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that due to lack of sufficient funding C-Tran fixed route and complementary Paratransit service should be terminated effective 11:59 P.M. March 31, 2010;

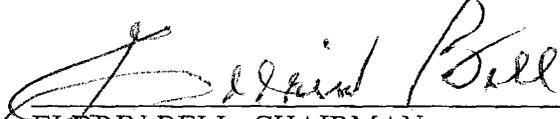
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the termination of C-Tran Fixed route and complementary Para Transit services to be effective 11:59 P.M. March 31, 2010. The Board of Commissioners further directs the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and the Public Transit Coordinator to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the termination of the Operations Agreement between MARTA and the County dated September 27, 2007 in accordance with the terms of said Operations Agreement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this 13th day of October, 2009.

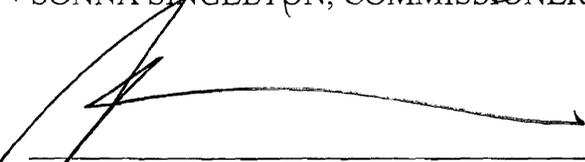

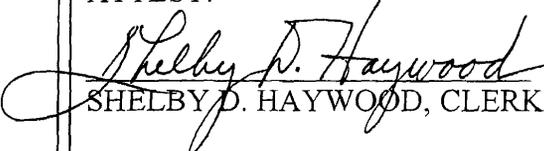
