RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 176

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO THREE SEPARATE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING WITH ATLANTA TECHNICAL COLLEGE ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIRE FIGHTER I TCC AND FIRE FIGHTER II TCC TRAINING, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY BASIC (EMT-B) AND INTERMEDIATE (EMT-I) TCC TRAINING, AND PARAMEDIC TECHNOLOGY TRAINING FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE & EMERGENCY SERVICES WILL BE ADMINISTERED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PROVIDE FOR AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Beginning on January 1, 2013, The National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians will require that all paramedics receive their training at a location that is accredited through the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools ("SACS"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed affiliation with Atlanta Technical College will allow the Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services to meet this requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners (the "County") on behalf of the Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services desires to enter into a contract with Atlanta Technical College on behalf of the CCFES to meet the aforementioned requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by entering into the Memoranda of Understanding as contemplated therein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to enter three (3) separate Memoranda of Understanding on behalf of the Clayton County Fire & Emergency Services with Atlanta Technical College providing for the terms and conditions under which Fire Fighter I TCC and Fire Fighter II TCC training, Emergency Medical Technology Basic (EMT-B) and Intermediate (EMT-I) TCC training, and Paramedic Technology training for the employees of the Clayton County Fires and Emergency Services will be administered.. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Memoranda of Understanding and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to provide for an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Memoranda of Understanding. The Memoranda of Understanding are attached hereto.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
