RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 217

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE POLICE ACADEMY AS A SEPARATE DEPARTMENT OF CLAYTON COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF ALL PERSONNEL CURRENTLY IN THE POLICE ACADEMY AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF HUMAN RESOURCES TO DO ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE TRANSFER OF SUCH PERSONNEL; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE ACADEMY TO REFLECT THE LINE ITEM TRANSFERS RELATING THERETO; TO AUTHORIZE ALL OTHER ACTS REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Police Academy is currently a part of the Police Department of Clayton County under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the citizens, and the County will best be served by transferring the operation of the Police Academy from Police Department and establish a separate Department to be headed by the Academy Director.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the establishment of a separate department to be known as the Clayton County Police Academy and further authorizes the transfer of the operation of the Police Academy, (including all personnel and related


equipment) under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners from the Clayton County Police Department, to the Police Academy to be headed by the Academy Director. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Human Resources to do all acts necessary to effectuate the transfer of all personnel currently in the Academy from the Police Department. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the respective budgets of the Police Academy and Police Departments to reflect the line item transfers relating thereto. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes all other acts required to implement this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on today's date.




