A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 1094 TO AMEND THE HOTEL/MOTEL LODGING TAX. TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.






