RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 197

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTA PROVIDING FOR RECIPROCAL RESPONSE TO EMERGENCIES WITHIN EACH RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the laws of Georgia authorize local governments to provide mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an Agreement to provide mutual aid in emergencies subject to the availability of resources; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into the Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a reciprocal Agreement with the City of Atlanta to provide assistance in the event of a police emergency subject to the availability of resources.



Agreement and to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.




