RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 230

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF UNSERVICEABLE COUNTY PROPERTY AT PUBLIC SALE; TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY BY THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County owns certain worn out, useless, and other surplus property that has been used to such an extent that it is advisable to sell or otherwise dispose of the property (“unserviceable property”); and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the property sought to be disposed of can no longer be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by such property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the unserviceable property at public sale in accordance with applicable County Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS




Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, through the Director of Central Services, to sell or otherwise dispose of unserviceable County property on the list attached hereto, and any other property received by Central Services deemed unserviceable up to the date of the public sale. The disposition shall be in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Sec. 2-147 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






