RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 148

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH EMERGINET PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS PLACED IN CUSTODY OR OTHERWISE DETAINED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT REQUIRING EMERGENCY HEALTH CARE SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (the "County") desires to provide appropriate emergency health care for individuals placed in custody or otherwise detained by law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, EmergiNet will bill the County for those individuals that EmergiNet believes were in the custody or otherwise detained by law enforcement officials whose health care is the responsibility of Clayton County at a 22% discount off of billed charges; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by entering into the Contract with EmergiNet for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Contract with EmergiNet providing for the terms and conditions for individuals placed in custody or

otherwise detained by law enforcement requiring emergency health care services. The Contract shall be in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Contract, with such minor changes, insertions or deletions, and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.





Dear Mr. Howell:

This letter will serve as a contract between Clayton County and EmergiNet for individuals placed in custody or otherwise detained by law enforcement who require health care services.

EmergiNet will bill Clayton County for those individuals that EmergiNet believes were in the custody or otherwise detained by law enforcement officials and whose health care is the responsibility of Clayton County.

Clayton County agrees to review the account within (30) days to determine if the individual's health care is the responsibility of Clayton County and if so, will remit to EmergiNet 78% of billed charges (representing a 22% discount off billed charges) as payment in full. If the determination of responsibility for the individual's health care and/or payment is not received by EmergiNet within the 30 day period, the agreed discount will not be applicable.

If it is determined that the individual's health care is not the responsibility of Clayton County, the invoice will be returned to EmergiNet with a statement indicating such information. If the County requires more than (30) days to determine responsibility, it is agreed that EmergiNet will be contacted and a mutual extension will be agreed upon.

Both parties agree to provide written advance notice of any changes to any contracts under this agreement. This contract will become effective upon the date of execution by EmergiNet.

If this letter accurately reflects the agreement between Clayton County and EmergiNet, please sign both copies enclosed and return one of them to me. The second copy is for your file.
