RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 158

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF CERTAIN VEHICLE PARTS ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH INVESTIGATION OF CRIMINAL ACTIVITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO ACCEPT THE DONATION ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, AND TO RECORD FIXED ASSETS AS NECESSRY, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, James Robinson owns certain vehicle parts (the "Equipment") that are presently being used in the daily operations of the Clayton County Police Department; and; and

WHEREAS, James Robinson desires to donate the Equipment to Clayton County; and,

WHEREAS the donated Equipment will be utilized by the Clayton County Police Department for investigation of criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by accepting the donation of Equipment from James Robinson for the above-stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept certain vehicle parts from James Robinson to be used by the Clayton County Police Department for criminal investigations. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute any documents necessary, and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, and to record fixed assets as necessary, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2007.





I am making this gift without conditions for the consideration of being allowed to equip the County owned Dodge Magnum under cover vehicle used by me in my duties as a narcotics agent for the County with the said wheel and tires.

I affirm to Clayton County that I am the legal owner of these wheels, tires and locking lugs having purchased these from Big Dog Auto and Truck Repair, 140 Blalock Street, Hapeville, Georgia for the amount of \$1,075.00. A bill of sale of this transaction has been provided to the County.

I acknowledge that I have discussed the type of wheels and tires that I am giving to the County with the County Fleet Maintenance director and understand these wheels and tires are approved for normal use.

I acknowledge that the County is under no obligation to nor will it replace any wheel or tire that becomes, lost, stolen, damaged or other wise unusable.

I acknowledge that by signing this form I understand that I am making an unconditional gift of four (4) wheels, tires and locking lugs valued at \$1,075.00, to Clayton County and that this gift is irrevocable and transfers all of my rights in these wheel rims to Clayton County.
