ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - 181

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, CHAPTER 94, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE III PARKING , STOPPING AND STANDING, SO AS TO AMEND SAID CHAPTER AND ARTICLE AND TO DELETE IN ITS ENTIRETY THE PRESENT SECTION 94-58 "PROHIBITED PARKING OF ANY TRUCK TRACTOR, BUS, TRAILER OR SEMI TRAILER, ON RIGHT-OF-WAY IN AREA ZONED RESIDENTIAL", AND ITS SUBSECTIONS, AND TO SUBSTITUTE IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 94-58 "MULTI-WHEELED VEHICLES AND BUSES ON STREET PARKING PROHIBITED WITHIN RESIDENTIAL ZONED DISTRICT", AND SUBSECTIONS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1. The CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, Chapter 94, Traffic and Vehicles, Article III Parking, Stopping and Standing, by deleting the present Section 94-58, entitled "Prohibited parking of any truck tractor, bus, trailer, or semi-trailer, on right-of-way in area zoned residential", and substituting in lieu there of a new Section 94-58, "Multi-wheeled vehicles and buses on street parking prohibited within residential zoned district" to read as follows:

**"Section 94-58 Multi-wheeled vehicles and buses on street parking prohibited within residential zoned district.**

(a) With the exception of commercial vehicles parked temporarily in conjunction with a service, sale, delivery or pick-up, vehicles having more than four wheels, including major recreational equipment, school buses and other buses, truck tractors, trucks having more than four wheels, trailers and semi-trailers are prohibited from parking on residential streets or within the public right-of-way of a residential zoned district.

(b) Such vehicles are declared a nuisance and a hazard to traffic and law enforcement officials of the county are authorized and empowered to impound any vehicle found to be in violation of this section. The owner of such vehicle shall be responsible for all expenses and charges incurred in the towing and storage of the vehicle. At the discretion of the law enforcement officer, a vehicle parked in violation of this section may be released to the owner or driver if the vehicle is then immediately removed.

(c) The vehicle owner, or driver if different from the owner, may be punished as provided in section 1-12 of the Code of Clayton County for a violation of this section."


Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




