RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 101

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A JOINT TERRORISM TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE M.O.U.; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE TERMS OF THE M.O.U.; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigation has created a Joint Terrorism Task Force with participation from various area law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the County police department has been invited to participate in this valuable program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by participation in this Joint Terrorism Task Force.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, or the Chief of Police as the Chairman's designee to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to participate in a Joint Terrorism Task Force. The FBI may provide a vehicle and radio for the County employee assigned to the Task Force. Additionally, the FBI will reimburse the County for overtime payments subject to the availability of funds. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to

otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.



Legislative Request Form

Purpose

To request a resolution to authorize the County Police Department to participate in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Joint Terrorism Task Force.

Rationale

The purpose of the Joint Terrorism Task Force is to deter, defeat and respond to terrorist attacks. The location of Hartsfield airport in our county urges our participation in this Task Force. Participation will allow us access to information vital for the protection of our citizens and their property.

Facts

The FBI has created the Joint Terrorism Task Force to facilitate the exchange the intelligence information. The FBI will provide a vehicle to our officer who may use the vehicle for official purposes.

Impact

No additional cost beyond salary and benefits for the officer assigned to the task force. The F.B.I. will reimburse the County for overtime payments to this officer subject to availability of funds.
