RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 102

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF CONDEMNED OR SEIZED VEHICLES FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT DRUG/GANG VIOLENCE TASK FORCE TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE SALE OF SAID VEHICLES AS SURPLUS ITEMS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Drug/Gang Violence Task Force has seized sixteen (16) vehicles described in the attached list during criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug/Gang Violence Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicles to Clayton County (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County has forfeited said vehicles to the County under court order in the respective case numbers; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles are not acceptable to be put in service as County vehicles and it is advisable to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicles ("unserviceable vehicles"); and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicles sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used to benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by accepting and disposing of the unserviceable vehicles at auction in accordance with applicable County Ordinance, with the proceeds from said auction to be placed into the 221 account, city sharing .

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept and auction the sixteen (16) unserviceable vehicles described in the attached list. The auction shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-147 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of these unserviceable vehicles shall be tendered to the County and placed into the 221 account, city sharing. The Directors of Central Services, Finance and Fleet Maintenance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


