RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 86

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ALLOW DREAM BIG EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, INC. TO SPONSOR AND HOST A 5K WALK-A-THON EVENT WHICH WILL COMMENCE FROM AND FINISH AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County has traditionally supported the work of various non-profit organizations, governmental agencies, and professional service providers located and conducting business in Clayton County for the benefit of the County's citizens; and

WHEREAS, as a fundraiser for Clayton County students to help raise funds for a week-long college tour in June 2010, Dream Big Educational Services, Inc. (the "Promoter") desires to sponsor and host on April 24, 2010 a 5K Walk-A-Thon event which will commence from and finish at the Clayton County International Park; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter shall have sole responsibility for organizing, promoting and managing the Walk-A-Thon, with no capital expense to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter is qualified to organize, promote and manage such an event; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by collaborating with the Promoter to present this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

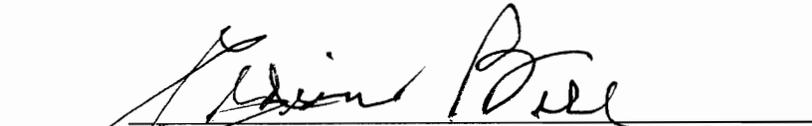
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to allow Dream Big Educational Services, Inc. to sponsor and host on April 24, 2010 a 5K Walk-A-Thon event which will commence from and finish at the Clayton County International Park, and serves as a fundraiser for Clayton County students to help raise funds for a week-long college tour in June 2010.

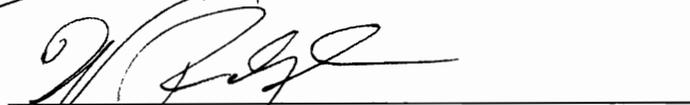

SO RESOLVED, this the 6th day of April, 2010.

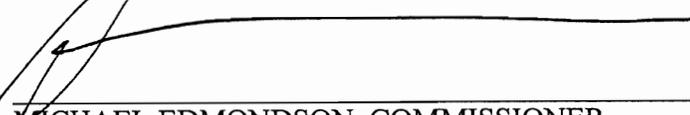

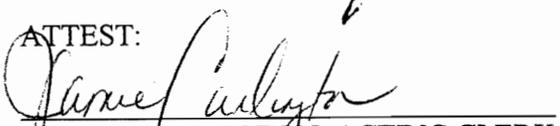
