ORDINANCE NO. 2018-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II, WATER AUTHORITY SEWER USE, OF SECTION 98, UTILITIES, OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY ORDINANCES GOVERNING THE CLAYTON COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY SEWER USE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of Clayton County, Georgia is the Chairman and Board of Commissioners of Clayton County, Georgia (hereinafter the “County”); and

WHEREAS, Article II, Authority Sewer Use of Section 98, Utilities, of the County Ordinances governs the uniform requirements for users of the publicly owned treatment works for Clayton County and enables Clayton County Water Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) to comply with all applicable state and federal laws that govern publicly owned treatment works; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the aforementioned Article and Section requires amending in order to update and otherwise remain current and with the laws of the State of Georgia and of the United States governing publicly owner treatment works; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has recommended to the County that said Article and Section of the County Ordinances be amended, and the Authority has prepared said amendment; and

WHEREAS, upon the County reviewing the Authority's recommended amendment, the County believes that Article II of Section 98 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances should be amended in accordance with the Authority's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Clayton County, Georgia, will be positively impacted by the adoption of this resolution.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY and by the authority thereof:

Section 1. County's Code is hereby amended by making the following substitution to the text of Article II, Water Authority Sewer Use, of Section 98, Utilities, of the Code of Ordinances for Clayton County, Georgia, by inserting the text contained on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Section 2. The preamble of this Ordinance shall be considered to be and is hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set out herein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia and the County.

Section 4. In the event any section, paragraph, subpart, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance shall be declared or adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portions declared invalid or unconstitutional had never been enacted into law.

Section 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.


Section 6. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless otherwise stated herein.
