RESOLUTION NO. 2018 – 39

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF RIVERDALE FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES (E-911); TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County staffs and maintains the Clayton County E-911 Communications Center as well as other resources for the purpose of receiving and dispatching emergency and non-emergency calls for Police, Sheriff, Fire and Emergency Service; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 46-5-134 allows for the collection of a monthly surcharge from telephone subscribers to fund the operation of an Emergency Telephone (E-911) System, and

WHEREAS, Clayton County and the City of Riverdale (jointly "the parties") have determined that there is a present and continuing need for providing Emergency Telephone System (E-911) and Emergency radio dispatch services to the City of Riverdale; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined that the best method to accomplish this joint activity is to have Clayton County's E-911 center serve as the public safety answering point for the City of Riverdale and also as the public safety radio dispatch center for the City of Riverdale:

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section III, Paragraph I of the Constitution of the State of Georgia provides that counties and municipalities may contract with each other for joint services; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement as authorized in Article IX, Section IV, Paragraph II and Article IX, Section III, Paragraph I of the Georgia Constitution for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Riverdale for the provision of Emergency Communications Services (E-911) for the purpose of providing public safety radio communications services to the City of Riverdale. The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense relating thereto. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


