RESOLUTION NO. 2018 – 63

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LOVEJOY FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (“the County”) maintains and staffs a fire department for the purpose of fire suppression, protection, prevention, rescue, emergency medical services, code enforcement, fire investigation, pre-construction plan review, existing fire compliance inspections and new construction inspections (collectively “Emergency Services”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Lovejoy (“the City”) has the right and authority to provide Emergency Services within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City and the County that the City shall reserve its right and authority to provide Emergency Services within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide Emergency Services within its corporate limits by contracting with the County for Provision of Emergency Services; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County previously entered into an agreement for the provision of fire and emergency services on July 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the County and the City have determined that it is to the mutual advantage and benefit of both parties hereto and their respective citizens that the County continue to render such Emergency Services to the city in the event of fire or other local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County desire to enter into a revised agreement for the provision of said services; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County desire that said revised agreement be substituted for the Provision of Fire and Emergency Services Agreement dated July 25, 2013 between the Parties, and further that said newly adopted agreement be substituted in place of the prior agreement as Exhibit E to the Service Delivery Strategy Agreement between the parties dated as of July 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the respective governing authorities represented by the signatories hereto to enter into this agreement as authorized in Article IX, Section IV, Paragraph II and Article IX, Section III, Paragraph I of the Georgia Constitution and Section 15-10-150 et seq. of the Official Code of Georgia and Section 4(3) of the Service Delivery Strategy Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Lovejoy for the provision fire suppression, protection, prevention, rescue, emergency medical services, code enforcement, fire investigation, pre-construction plan review, existing fire compliance inspections and new construction inspections (collectively referred to as “Emergency Services.” The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue

source and expense relating thereto. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


