RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 75

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH COMMUNITY INTERVENTION RESOURCES, LLC, A DOMESTIC LIMITED LIABILITY CORPORATION PROVIDING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CLAYTON COUNTY VETERAN'S TREATMENT COURT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County has received grant funds for use in establishing a Clayton County Veteran's Health Court; and

WHEREAS, the County has a need for a qualified entity to provide service and treatment provisions typically utilized in conjunction with such Court; and

WHEREAS, Community Intervention Resources, LLC has qualified, trained or experienced certified and licensed staff to meet the challenges faced by the criminal justice substance abuse and mental health populations; and

WHEREAS, the County, through its Superior Court, has determined that Community Intervention Resources' services are necessary and essential to the health, welfare, and safety of Clayton County citizens and shall best utilize the grant funds designated in establishing Clayton County's Veteran's Health Court; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into a contract for professional services with Community Intervention Resources, LLC to provide service and treatment provisions for the Clayton County Veteran's Health Court.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into an agreement for professional services with Community Intervention Resources, LLC. to provide services in connection with the Clayton County Veteran's Health Court.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman or his designee to execute the agreement and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the County's budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 4. The effective date of this Resolution shall be when approved by the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County.


