POST SUMMARY MINUTES

PRESENT: Vice-Chair Dorothy Foster-Hall, Secretary Ruth Ash, Board Member Diane Givens, Board Member Patricia Pullar, Supervisor Kamardi Carter, and Administrative Assistant Brianna Garrett

1. Vice-chair called the meeting to order.

2. Moment of silence observed.

3. Adoption of Agenda:

Motion made by Board Member Pullar, seconded by Board Member Givens. Vote Unanimous. Motion carried.

4. Approval of June 12, 2018 Regular Business Meeting Minutes.

No action was taken on the June 12, 2018 Regular Business Meeting Minutes.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT: Citizens will be given a three minute maximum time limit to speak before the Board of Elections and Registration about various topics, issues, and concerns. Public comments will be limited to thirty (30) minutes. Following thirty minutes of hearing from the public, the Board of Elections and Registration will allow the remainder of citizens who have signed up to be heard at the next regular business meeting.

A. Larry Auerbach, a volunteer from the Georgia Democratic Party of Georgia Voter Protection Team, informed the Board that he will serve as a liaison between Clayton County Board of Elections and Registration and the Georgia Democratic Party of Georgia.

6. Old Business:

A. Directives from Previous Meeting

The Board was presented with the training schedule and materials for poll workers as requested by Board Member Pullar.

The Board was presented a copy of the 2014-2015 fiscal year budget, along with the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget.

Supervisor Carter informed the Board that as of today, there were no correspondences received from the Secretary of State regarding any complaints from the 2017-2018 Election cycle.

7. New Business

A. Director's Report:

Supervisor Carter informed the Board that The Logic and Accuracy Testing on the Touch Screen and Optical Scan Voting Equipment to be used in the General Primary Runoff commenced June 8, 2018 and was completed June 25, 2018.

Supervisor Carter informed the Board that poll worker training is currently taking place for the 2018 July General Primary Runoff Election.

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Supervisor Carter informed the Board that As of July 1, there are 175,741 (159,864 Active; 17,492 Inactive) voters in Clayton County.

Supervisor Carter informed the Board that for the month of June, four Deputy Registrar activities were conducted.

Supervisor Carter informed the Board that 408 voters have casted a ballot and 217 mailed-in absentee ballots have been received during Advanced Voting as of July 10, 2018. Supervisor Carter also informed the Board that the numbers are updated daily.

There was no executive session at this time.

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


