- A. Director's Report & 2021 Election Updates

Director Dozier informed the Board that as of March 1, 2021, there are 207,189 (197,893 Active; 9,296 Inactive) Voters.

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Director Dozier informed the Board that High School Voter Registration Month is fast approaching in April. We will deputize Educators to assist in the month's events. Deputy Registrar classes will continue to be conducted via Zoom until further notice.

Director Dozier informed the Board that the 2021 GAVREO Conference is still scheduled for August 29 – September 1, 2021 with restrictions on the number of attendees per county. Additionally, the link for the hotel will be released on March 16, 2021. The Department does not have a county issued credit card therefore; each person attending must continue to make their own reservations. Once reservations are made, they can be submitted to Finance for payment.

Board Member Pullar inquired about students returning to in-school learning and any new processes involved as it relates to High School Voter Registration Month.

Board Member Pullar commented on incorporating a policy within the training that educates voters on the rights and eligibility of ex-offenders.

Director Dozier informed the Board that the office is inquiring about the potential of moving into the building with the renovations that are needed to ensure the needs of the office are met. Questions and concerns about renovations were presented to Building and Maintenance and other options outside of the old Code Enforcement building are being explored.

Chair Johnson suggested the shopping center located around the corner from the Elections & Registration Office be explored.

Director Dozier informed the Board that she will talk to Director Hopkins and look into the building as an option. It is a matter of securing the building, the cost of purchasing and renovations, and the overall potential of the building.
