

NOTICE EARLY PROCESSING OF ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Pursuant to Senate Bill 202 the Clayton County Board of Elections and Registration intends to begin processing absentee ballots cast for the May 24, 2022, General Primary and Special Elections Monday, May 16, 2022, through May 24, 2022.

The opening of ballot envelopes and scanning of ballots will begin each day at 9:00 AM and conclude at 5:00 PM until completed.

On Election Day, May 24, 2022, the processing of absentee ballots cast for the Special Elections will commence at 7:00 AM until completion.

A sign will be posted on the front door notifying the public if there is any change to this schedule or if activities are suspended for any period. This activity will take place at the Clayton County Board of Elections and Registration Elections Center, 7946 North McDonough Street, Jonesboro, Georgia 30236.

Early processing of absentee ballots shall be controlled, such that ballot secrecy is maintained. The collection or disclosure of any balloting information before the close of the polls at 7:00 P.M. on Election Day is strictly prohibited.

Any members of the public who wish to observe will be required to check in, receive a badge, take an oath, and relinquish cell phones or other electronic recording devices prior to viewing this process.
