The following report represents a summary and recap of major operations and activities that we have completed or are ongoing within Elections and Registration for the month of May 2022 and activities since the last Board meeting.

The key tasks performed within the office included processing voter registration applications, open record requests, confirmation notices, state-wide voter registration system trainings, poll worker recruitment, redistricting, candidate qualifying, voter outreach and education, and other various pre-election activities associated with the 2022 election cycle.

ELECTIONS

2022 Election Calendar:

As of this date the 2022 Election Calendar will remain as established. Below are the 2022 Election Year dates. These dates are subject to change and all do not necessarily yield an election in Clayton County. This information has been placed on our website.

SECRETARY OF STATE ANNOUNCES NEW STATEWIDE VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM:

During the month of January, Secretary Raffensperger announced via press conference Secretary of State Elections Systems team has partnered with Sales Force and MTX to develop the new statewide voter registration system: Georgia Registered Voter Information System (GARViS). The launch date of GARViS was March 29, 2022. On April 5, 2022 SOS held a Statewide Call to update counties on the project and informed that we'll return to using eNet for the May Primary/June Runoff, and resume daily registration processing and other election preparation activities. Our office processed all work that we conducted in GARViS since the launch date into eNet. The new public facing My Voter Page (MVP), Absentee Ballot Portal, and Online Voter Registration (OLVR) applications were not impacted by going back to eNet and voters should not see any changes in their online experience. However, any Absentee ballot applications submitted through the online portal will continue to flow to GARViS. We have assigned staff in our office to login to GARViS daily to print any absentee applications submitted through the portal and process in eNet. Advanced Voting Poll Worker Training will reflect this change and will not be introduced to GARViS for the May Primary. SOS indicated that GARViS will be used for the November General Election and this includes Advance Voting.
