The Annual 2014 PREA Report reflects this facility in a compliant manner. The Administrative Staff is pleased to advise that the prison met all standards and expectation of the policies pertaining to PREA. This facility houses a population of 230 inmates on average, with the mission of utilizing prison labor to successfully conduct and complete daily work production for the County. The Board of Commissioners, Warden, Deputy Warden, and Departments assist the daily functions of the prison work force with directives and projects that complement the community. All Staff and departments, approved to work with Inmates of The Department of Corrections, have been properly trained and instructed on Standards of PREA.

During the 2014 PREA Year, there were no incidents. All factors of safety and sanitation was found to be in satisfactory in the inspection of the building. The review of the layout of the facility proved to be safe, with no improprieties or endangerments. Each Inmate was documented with receiving the proper training on what PREA represents and on how to incorporate the standards into their protection and safety practices.
